Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn Term. This is a busy term and in this letter you will see dates of some future events. We are starting a **Breakfast Club** for pupils from Monday 17th November 2003. The Club opens for pupils between 7.50 to 8.50 am every day in the newly refurbished food tech area.

As well as breakfast afterwards there will be an opportunity for pupils to enjoy a range of 'family' board games, listen to music or story tapes, to chat or to visit a quiet area to read or draw.
