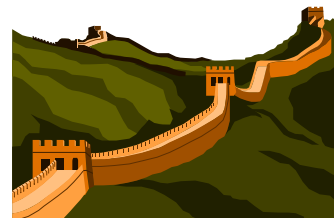

The Great Wall of China Preston Walk for UNICEF



Entry Fee £1.

Donated to UNICEF as part of our Rights Respecting Schools activity.

Start Time **12.15 – 12.30 p.m.**

End time **3.00 p.m.** back at school or earlier if picked up.

Route to Picnic.

Leave from turning circle towards Louviers Road. Keep to left. Turn left onto Louviers Road.

Cross Louviers Road and take track opposite marked with two large boulders. Walk across fields over the hill to edge of Lodmoor Country Park. The path here is generally sound.

Signpost here for Lodmoor Park or Preston. (Teachers of younger pupils may continue with walk or proceed to Country Park) **20 mins**

Turn left and follow Southdown Road at edge of Country Park and Nature Reserve until you reach path across RSPB site opposite Bosworth Home.

Walk down path to Preston Beach Road; turn left and head to Overcombe Corner near Joy's Convenience Store.

Use pelican crossing and cross to sea wall near Oasis Café. Note that you need to cross a minor road here also. **40 mins**

Walk along the wall up to the breakwater rocks and then return to the main road on your right.

Cross at the pelican crossing for Lodmoor Country Park.

Walk into Lodmoor Country Park and head for the large grass area on the right, passing the small children's railway for the school picnic. **65 mins**

TOILETS are located in the car park near the Café. There is a marked out zebra crossing point. Adults need to accompany all children. I would suggest children reach the picnic spot before any use is made of the toilets.

End of the picnic. Listen for a whistle to assemble and walk back.

At this point in time parents may take their children home.



Return Journey

To return walk towards the pitch and putt and along the path towards Littlemoor. You will then meet the junction with Southdown Road. Walk straight ahead up the hill on the grass path to Louviers Road.

From there return to school and headcount the children. **35 mins**

Children may then leave with their parents or wait for the 3.00 p.m. bell.

Some reminders

This is a non-uniform day. Please bring along a black bin bag for rubbish collection at the end of the picnic. Once at the picnic site children may join their parents otherwise they stay in class groups. Please take a class list with you. Children need a backpack to carry a picnic, which includes a drink.
